Restorative Reproductive medicine (RRM) is any scientific approach to reproductive medicine that seeks to cooperate with or restore the normal physiology and anatomy of the human reproductive system. It does not employ methods that are inherently suppressive, circumventive or destructive. This approach respects the integrity of the human person and the patients' right to understand and cooperatively manage their own fertility, with appropriate medical assistance.
